Typical Duties

Generally, you'll work alongside the dental operator, helping provide quality customer-focused oral healthcare for patients via:

- Supporting infection control practices
- Performing dental reception duties
- Contributing to the administration of the practice.

Education and Training to become qualified

- 12 month full-time traineeship
- Training is usually conducted on the job, with a RTO representative coming along every 6-8 weeks with workbooks and assignments for the trainee to complete.

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
